The Challenge

For the Oklahoma Department of Human Services (DHS), a broken system was compounded by budget constraints. The invoicing process was cumbersome and slow in making payments to childcare providers, resulting in unwillingness by some to accept cases. Worse, audits and other evidence suggested a troublingly high percentage of incorrect payments – errors that misdirected funds meant to help families. While eager to correct these issues, DHS faced fiscal constraints, increasing the challenge.

The Solution

DHS determined that most issues could be addressed with a combination of policy changes and enhanced tracking. The State needed a way to document and pay for childcare at the point of service, while verifying eligibility in real time. Then the department could compensate providers for actual services provided – and eliminate retroactive paperwork and undocumented claims for payment.
